Removal of name from the register for Emergency Care Practitioner (Basic).

Section 25(1)(c) of the Allied Health Professions Act, 2004 (Act No. 7 of 2004) prescribes that the Allied Health Professions Council 'may remove from the register concerned the name of any registered person who has failed to pay to the Council on or before 31 March of the year concerned the annual fees determined by the Council and payable by that registered person'.

Seeing that we have no proof that you have paid your annual fee for 2024, you are hereby notified that your name has been removed from the register for Emergency Care Practitioner (Basic) and your registration certificate is regarded to be withdrawn with immediate effect. You must immediately cease to practice your profession or to perform any act which no person other than a registered person may perform.

Should you continue to practice your profession once you receive this letter, you will be committing a criminal offence and upon conviction, you are liable to a fine not exceeding N\$20,000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding five years or the both such fine and such imprisonment.

If you wish to have your name restored to the register, you must complete the attached application form for restoration and pay to Council an amount of N\$ 1,455 in addition to the annual fee of N\$ 585. If you are employed, a copy of this letter may be forwarded to your employer.
